Church Family,

During our journey through the gospel of Mark together, we saw this past week how answering the call to true discipleship will lead to the best year of our lives in 2010. Because of FBC's commitment to making disciples, I believe with all my heart that we are going to experience a year that as Paul describes in Ephesians will be, "More than all we ask or imagine according to His power that is at work within us."

Sunday, January 3rd, we will begin two worship services and two Sunday schools to accommodate our ever growing church family. With your help, this much needed schedule change gives us an incredible opportunity to reach even more people in our area with the good news of Jesus Christ.

In addition to the schedule change, we are going to add to our facilities. These changes will enable us to meet every ministry need while at the same time keeping our indebtedness to a minimum. Our most important spatial needs involve preschool, youth, fellowship, Sunday school, and parking.

To meet these needs we'll purchase a modular office complex to be placed on the east side of our property. These new offices will provide our staff more room while freeing up the second floor of Ellis Hall for additional preschool and adult Sunday School space. We also have the opportunity to purchase and renovate a building, over 6,000 square feet, to have the best youth ministry center in our area. This will provide our young people the space they need. This will also free up the space they are currently using on the second floor of the discipleship annex to be converted into adult Sunday school space. Finally, we will renovate the Christian Life Center with a larger, updated kitchen and a facelift to the gym area. Since we are feeding more people on Wednesday nights than ever, having an updated space with an adequate kitchen is vital to our Wednesday night ministry.

The total cost of all of these additions and renovations is less than one million dollars, which will keep our total indebtedness less than two million. By taking this plan of action we allow ourselves the opportunity to purchase additional properties surrounding our church's campus for future growth and expansion. Also, this plan does not take away any parking spaces on our campus and this is a very important commodity to our Sunday ministry. I am proud of the long range planning team's hard work and excellent proposal. God continues to bless as we are, "**LEADING EVERYDAY PEOPLE TO LOVE JESUS AND MAKE HIM KNOWN.**"
